PROCEEDINGS AND DOCUMENTS**



Now before the Court is a matter titled *Motion for a Ruling on Whether Hearings Will Be Open or Closed and Whether Filings Shall Be Made Under Seal or Open, Public Record*, filed March 6, 2006. This motion was brought by Joshua Wolf, from whom the federal government has subpoenaed video footage related to a July 8, 2005 protest in San Francisco against the G8 Summit then taking place in Perthshire, Scotland. Through the motion, Mr. Wolf requests that the Court make this matter public subject to the government raising any issue that would disclose a "matter occurring before a grand jury." On March 23, 2006, the government filed its nonopposition to Mr. Wolf's request.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that all filings and hearings in this matter shall occur on the open record, unless otherwise ordered by the Court. Further, all materials currently held under seal shall be made part of the open record. A party wishing to file a sealed document must follow the procedures set out in the local rules. A party wishing to close a hearing to the public must make a request in writing at least one week before the scheduled hearing.
